*When it comes to cell phone safety for your children,
there are many tools for parents*

- For tweens: If you believe your child needs a mobile phone, purchase one designed for children such as Kajeet or Firefly. For others, consider a contact white list, GPS, and block photos, Internet and texting
- For teens: Put restrictions on usage such as time of day or geographical location, while still allowing contact with the parent's phone. Consider blocking Internet usage, photos, and installing a GPS locator
- Monitoring software is available via software companies to allow you to keep track of phone calls and texts
- New GPS technology disables texting at 10mph or more
