



the sale of lots or otherwise, shall be paid to the Finance Director of the Town of Barrington, who shall hold the same in a special fund and shall pay and distribute the same only on the written order of the Commissioners, and the Finance Director of the Town shall invest the moneys so received in such manner as the Commissioners shall direct. The Commissioners shall each year make a report to the Council, setting forth in full their acts an itemized statement of all moneys received and paid out, and for what purposes. The Commissioners shall also have charge of all lands within the Town of Barrington which shall be conveyed to the Town in trust for burial purposes, and shall have the management of all funds which shall be paid over to the Town for the purpose of ornamenting, keeping in repair, or improving burial lots shall execute all trusts in relation to cemeteries and burial lots in accordance with the terms contained in the instruments creating the same; the funds, however, to be in the custody of the Finance director of the Town, who shall invest the same as directed in writing by the Commissioners. The Commissioners shall direct investment of the funds in accordance with a written investment policy adopted by the Commissioners in consultation with the Finance Director and approved by resolution of the Council. In like manner, the investment policy may be amended from time to time. The Commissioners shall perform all acts in relation to cemeteries and burial grounds belonging to the Town of Barrington which previously were performed by the Council of the Town. Any vacancy occurring by the death or resignation of any commissioner shall be filled by the Council.

Explanation:

This proposal would change the number of members on the Cemetery Commission from 3 to 5.
