

Police Department

The Barrington Police Department is comprised of 25 sworn police officers and 6 civilian men and women who are dedicated to preserving the rights, property, safety and dignity of the people of this community. Last year, the Police Department and School District added a School Resource to aid in our police services. UNIFORM DIVISION

Twenty-two uniformed police officers responded to approximately 29,254 calls for service, handled 1,433 incident reports, made 264 criminal arrests, stopped 4,353 motor vehicles, investigated 376 accidents, issued 1045 citations, and gave out 3,308 verbal warnings during FY-2016.

ANIMAL CONTROL

Animal Control Officer Patricia Watson received over 627 calls for animal control services ranging from loose dogs and cats, wild animals, animal cruelty and barking dog complaints last year. Animal Control filed 72 formal reports and issued 81 summonses in FY-2016.

DETECTIVE DIVISION

The Department is staffed with only 2 full time detectives, Captain Dino DeCrescenzo and Det. Ben Ferreira, who investigated and solved dozens of felony and misdemeanor cases.

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

During the year, patrol officers logged over 549 different Community Policing/Relations efforts throughout the town. These contacts include speaking to business employees/owners in the Barrington Shopping Center, walkers on the East Bay Bike Path, Town Beach, and stopping by our schools and playgrounds. Cub Scout and Brownie Troop tours at the Police Station usually occur monthly.
